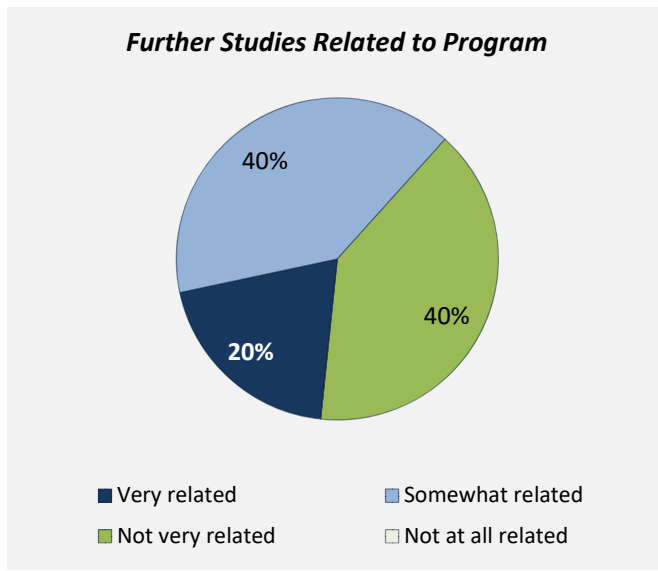

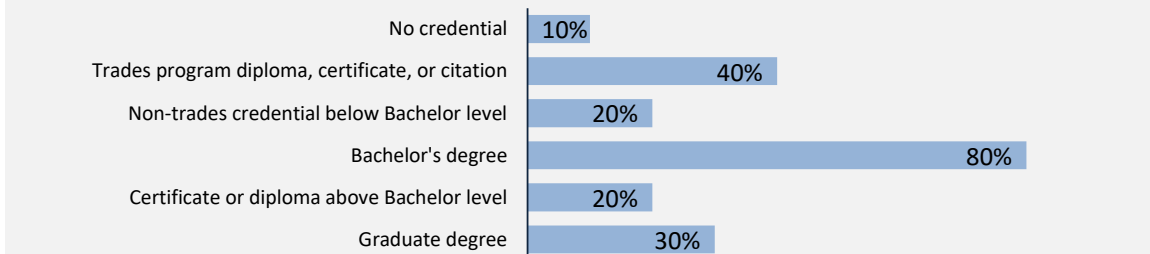

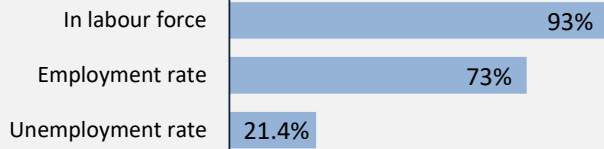

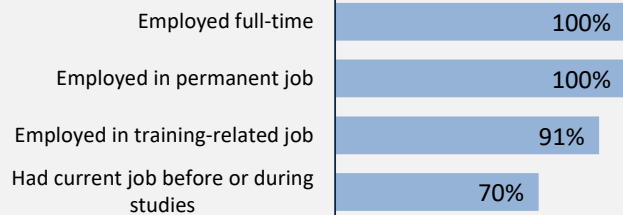

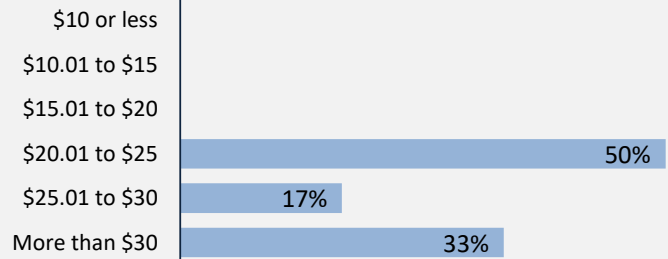

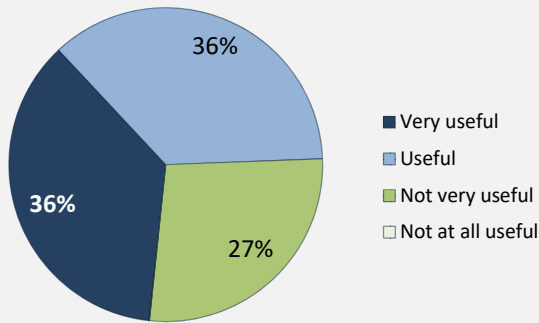

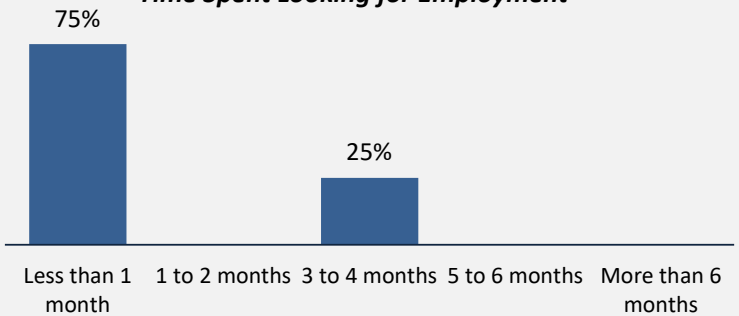
**Hourly Wage Group (main job)**

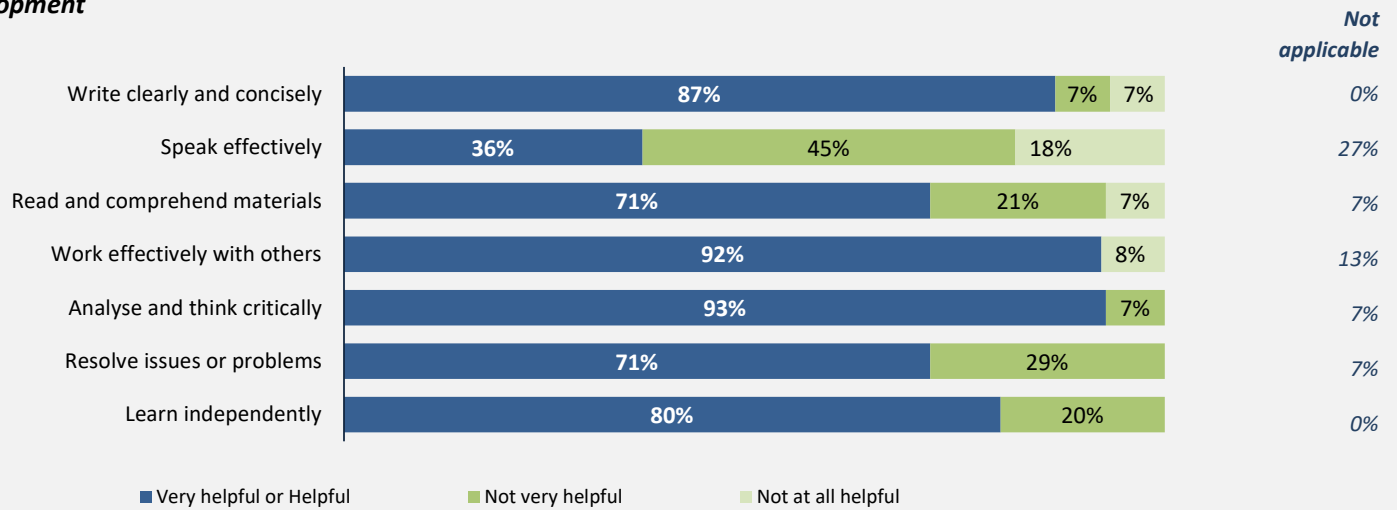

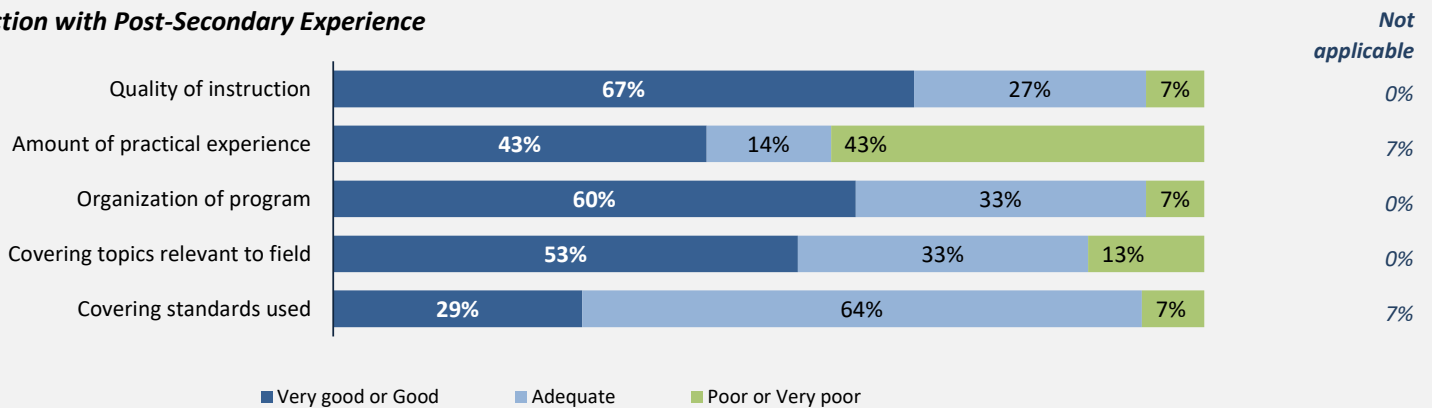
